Do you have one of those old-style two-channel amps and want more distortion out of it ? Good, no problem - all you need for this is a simple standard patch cable (shielded) !!!



Simply plug in your guitar into the first input jack of channel 1. Run a short shielded patch cable from the second input jack of channel 1 to the first input jack of channel two and you re done !

This old school trick works best with old Fender amps without master volume, but also on those later versions with master volume (mostly silverface amps). All the controls are interactive and with the volume controls of channel 1 and channel two you can dial in the distortion you want. The way it works is very simple, the signal from channel 1 will overload the input of channel two and the signal will clip (=distort) and that 's it.

So get some ear-protectors, plug in and enjoy ;-)
